

HPV Vaccination is **CANCER PREVENTION**



70-75%
of sexually active
men and women will get
at least one HPV infection
in their lifetime.



Many HPV infections will go away on their own,
but others can lead to cancer.

HPV infections are related to:



80% to 90% of
anal cancers



40% to 50% of
penile cancers



40% of vaginal and
vulvar cancers



25% to 35% of mouth
and throat cancers

and almost **ALL cases of cervical cancer**

Most of these cancers are related to high-risk HPV types 16 and 18.
