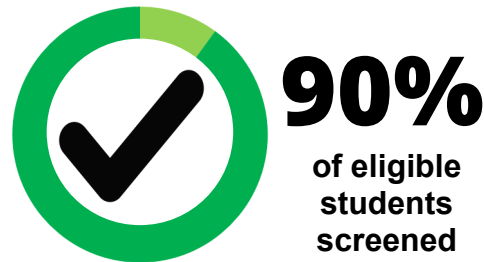
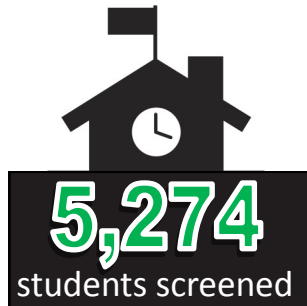


ORAL HEALTH Annual Report 2016

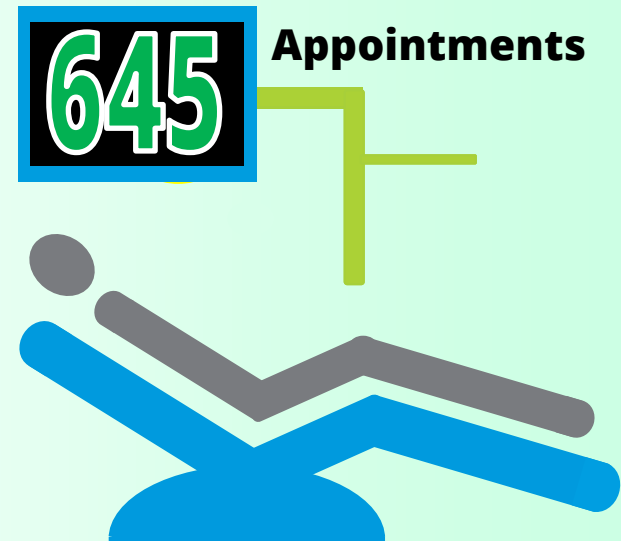
Why does this matter?
