Once you are a certified food handler...

- You will have the knowledge needed to prepare food safely
- You will have a skill sought after by employers in the food industry

Who should become a certified food handler?

Anyone who works in food preparation, such as restaurant worker, daycare employee, hospital/nursing home staff.



What topics will be covered?

- Food safety legislation
- Foodborne illness and food allergies
- Microorganisms
- The Food Safety Sequence from receiving to reheating and everything in between

What will I receive?

- A course manual
- A probe thermometer
- A wallet card certificate valid for 5 years (upon completion)

When is this course available?
