
## **Oral Health Annual Report 2018-19**

## **School Screening**

Hastings Prince Edward Public Health conducts oral health assessment and surveillance of children in all elementary schools in order to meet the Ontario Public Health Standards.

Data presented based on 2018/19 school year results.







**84%** of students were recommended **TOPICAL FLUORIDE** 

**10%** of students were recommended **SEALANTS** 

**7%** of students were recommended **SCALING** 

Almost 1 in 5 students screened had decay.



**59%** 

of those with decay were in **urgent need** of treatment.

Good oral health is important for a child's self-esteem, sense of well being, and their overall health.

Cavities and gum disease can be painful, lead to infections, and impact a child's sleep, eating and ability to learn.




## **Summer Community Screening**
