There is an opening for a Public Health Inspector Practicum within the Environmental Health team, working out of the Kingston office.

The successful candidate will fulfill the requirements of the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors Board of Certification and will assist in the delivery of applicable programs and services under the Ontario Public Health Standards. While under the direction of a certified Public Health Inspector, the successful candidate will carry out the duties and responsibilities related to a general Environmental Health program, including the inspection of food establishments, special events, personal services settings, small drinking water systems, public pools, and spas.

The candidate will be a graduate of an institution in Canada that has an approved Environmental Health program that leads to certification as a public health inspector. They will also have a valid Ontario driver's license, reliable vehicle and public liability and property damage insurance, proficiency with computers and related software, and willingness to work flexible hours and travel throughout the health unit region.
